TAPPAN ZEE BRIDGE/I-287 ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

Decision:

- Build one, high-quality shared use path on the north side of the replacement bridge
- Create a sense of place for pedestrians and bicycles
- Provide access to bicycle/pedestrian connections at the landings

How we got here:

- Agencies are committed to non-motorized transportation
- Formed Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Panel with adjacent communities representatives and bicycle/pedestrian advocates to advise project team
